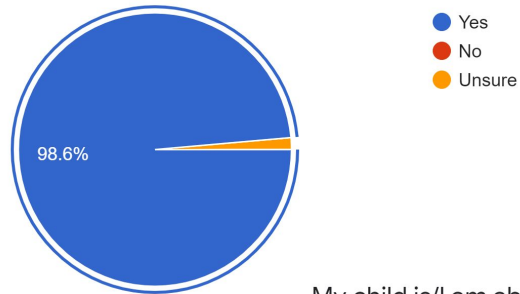

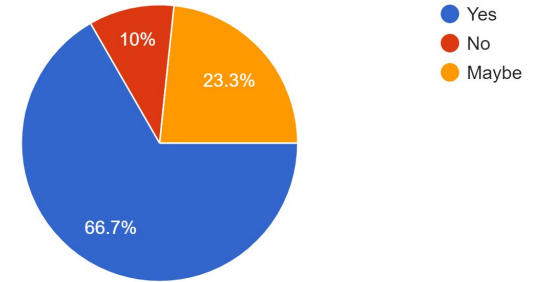

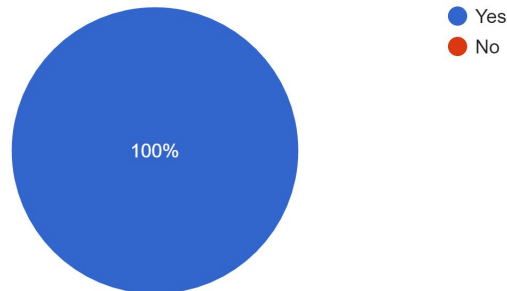

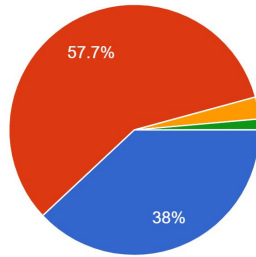

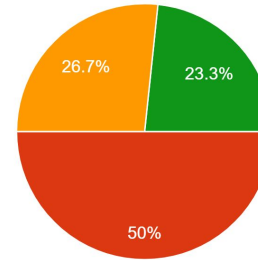

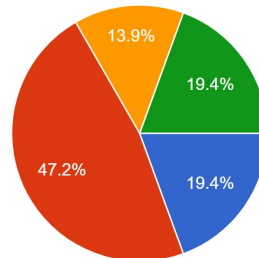

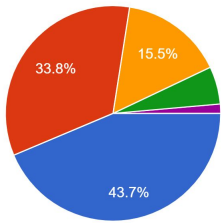

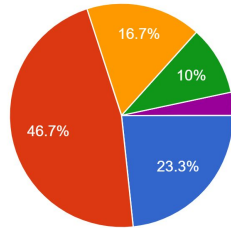

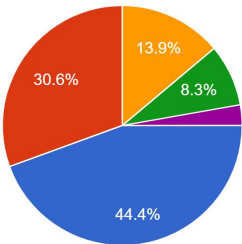

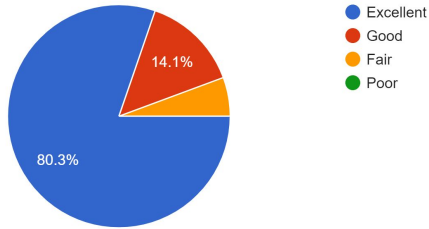

Response Time

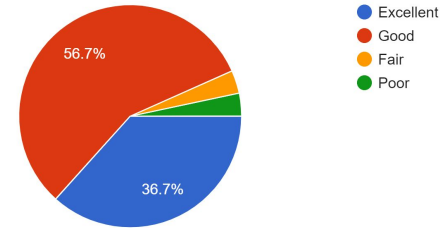

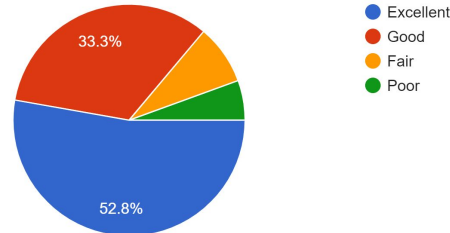

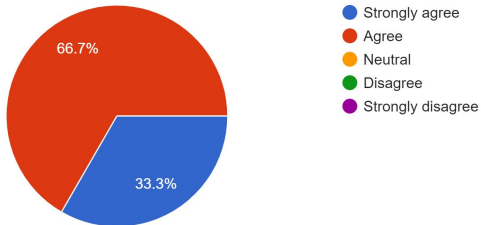

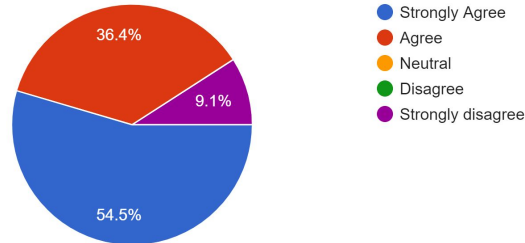

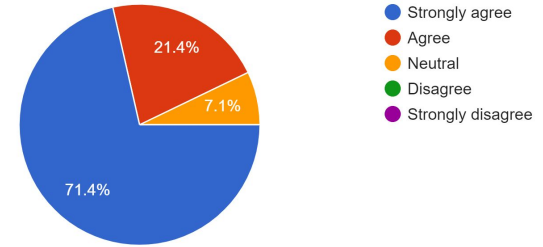
Middle School

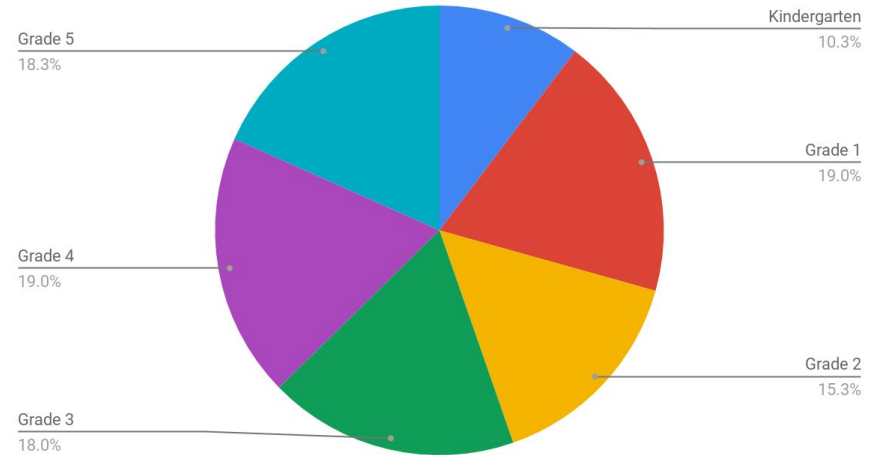

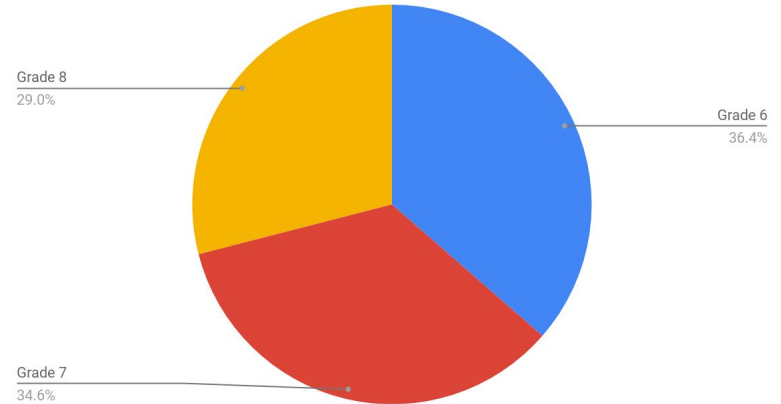

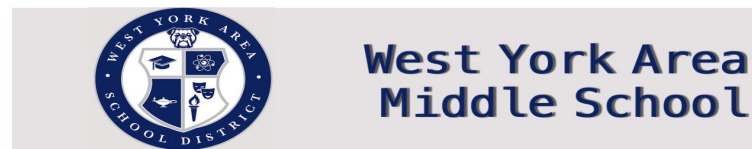

Middle School WYCA Enrollment Breakdown (162 students)

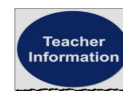


Middle School Model

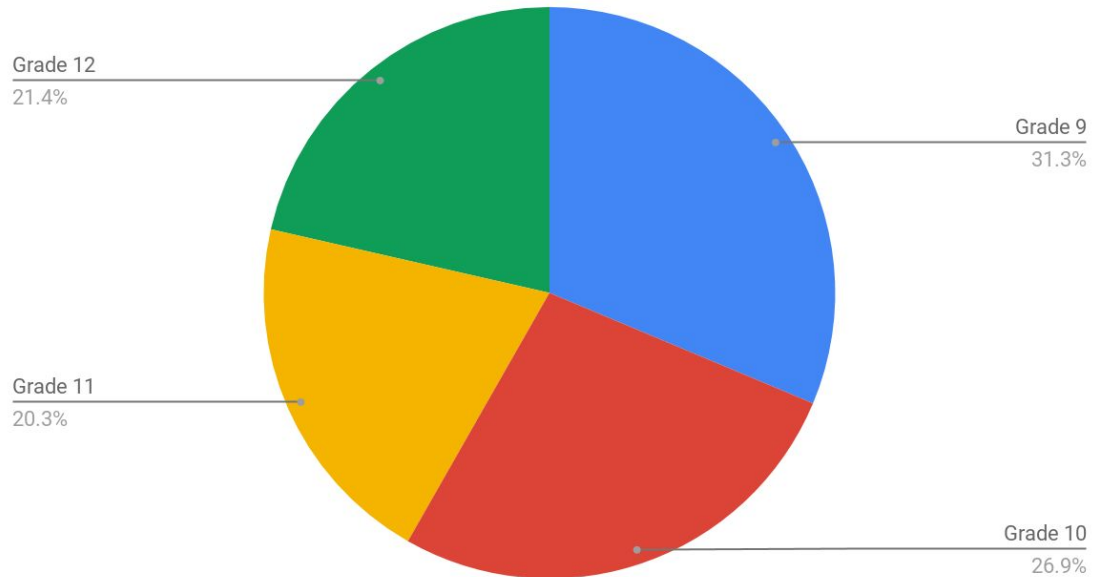
